The Great Pacific Race 2014

Rules of the race

- The Great Pacific Race 2014 is a race from Monterey Bay (California) to Hawaii with no stops and no assistance
- 3 categories : Solo, pair and four
- The start of the race is scheduled for June 2014 – the exact date will depend of the weather forecasts
- This journey is over 2100 nautical miles, about 3900km with only muscle power
- A pair boat may take between 35-80 days to reach Honolulu

- Win the race and set a world record in our category

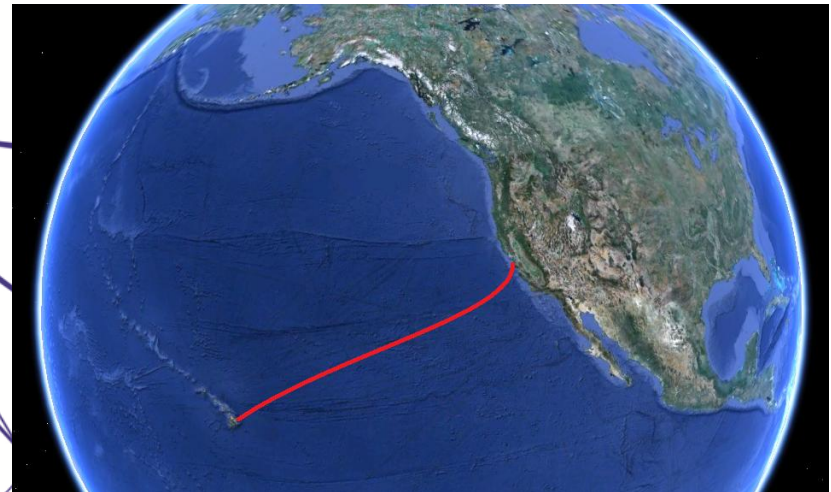

The history of the route

- The California-Hawaii crossing has never been completed in a pair boat
- Mick Bird holds the record of the crossing, rowing solo in 64 days (1997)

Boat & equipments



General description

- Unsinkable ocean rowing boat with two watertight cabins (one crew shelter and one storage cabin) and a rowing position between the two cabins
- Between 7 and 9 meters long
- Weighing about 500 kg without equipment; 1000 kg with

Excerpt of the equipment list

- Energy: Solar panels
- Food and water : 2 watermakers & freeze-dried dishes, etc
- Communication : VHF, satphone; the internet, etc
- Navigation : GPS, parachute-anchors, charts, etc
- Safety : liferaft, lifejackets, EPIRBS, etc

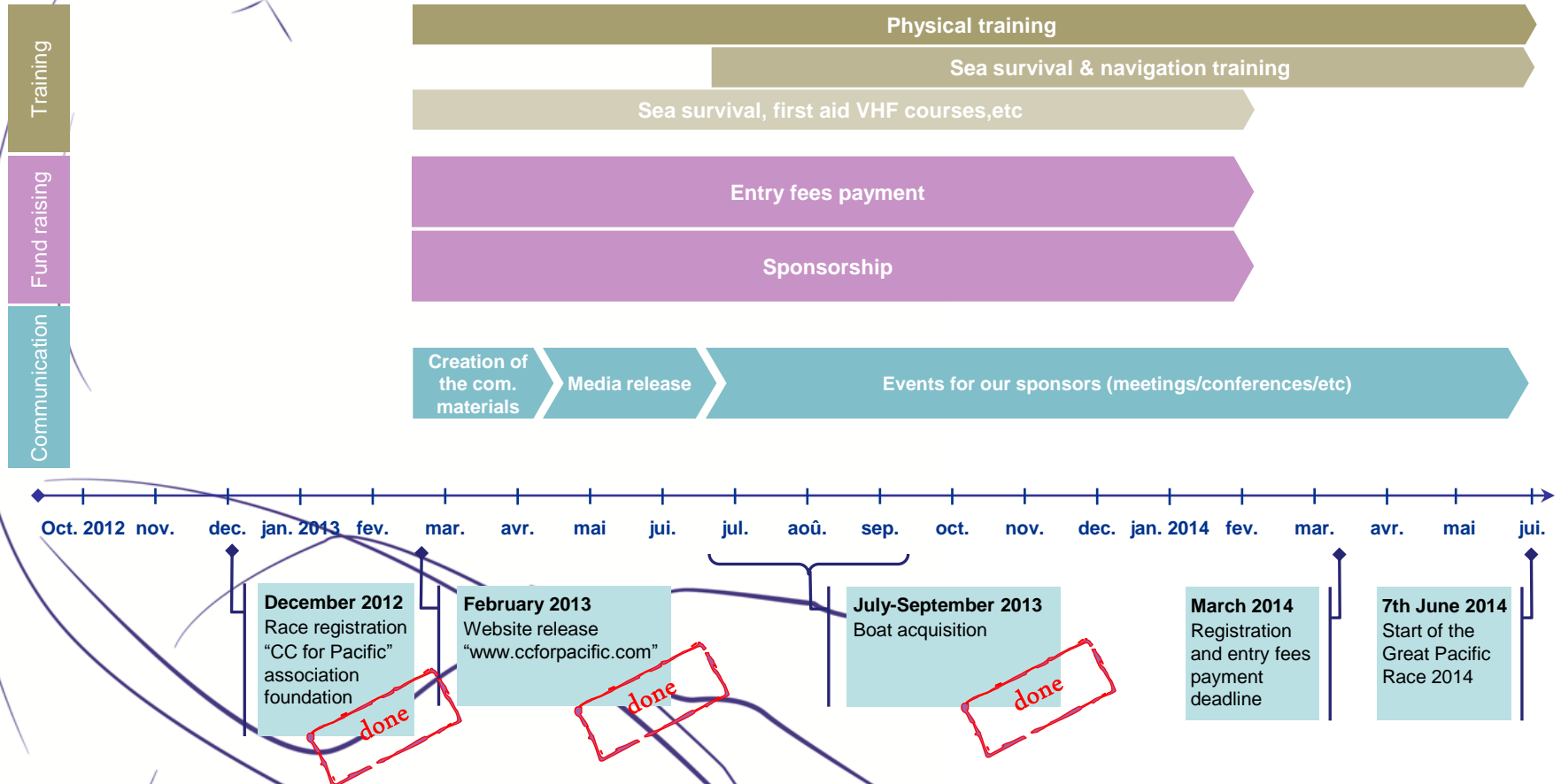

1. Acquisition of a second hand boat with equipment (cheapest option). The boat and the equipment have to be considered as capital expenditure, because they will be sold after the race
2. Before a crossing a boat needs to be fully scrutinized, improvements and repairs

3. NOW fees : Race entry fees payed to the organizer New Ocean Wave
 - **Notice** : This is a comprehensive budget, in line with similar races. The estimations have been made considering the worst case scenario

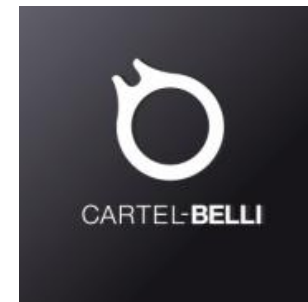
